

We shall celebrate the Ascension of the Lord on Thursday and nine days after, the feast of the Pentecost – that is the birth of the church and Easter season would be over. On this Sunday we read the preparatory speech of Jesus to his disciples on the night before he suffered, promising them of another Advocate. But there is a condition for the coming of the second Advocate – trust and love to the person of Jesus. The other Advocate will be with us forever as Jesus leaves the scene physically. His job will be our defence and leading us to discover the truth. He is the Comforter and the source of our courage especially when things do not go as we expect. He will be the liaison officer between us, Jesus and the Father. This Advocate is the Holy Spirit and he will fully manifest on the day of Pentecost.

ASCENSION THURSDAY:- (Holy day of obligation): We celebrate the feast of the Lord's Ascension. There are Masses at 9.15 am in St Thomas and at 7pm at St Sebastian.

PENTECOST SUNDAY: Pentecost is the feast of the descent of the Holy Spirit on the disciples and the birth of the Church. It is also the foundational feast of the Spiritans (Holy Ghost Fathers). Traditionally in Manchester, parishioners of the parishes where we work gather at St Anne's Church, Ancoats M4 7EQ, for a community Mass. The Mass starts at 12 noon. Everyone is invited. On Pentecost Sunday, we shall ask you to support us in our missions. With the Bishop's permission there will a second collection for the Spiritan missions.
