<u>Curriculum Overview</u> <u>Year 1 Autumn</u>

 Homework will be set on Fridays. Please return completed work by the following Tuesday. PE will be on Mondays and Fridays. Please send your child to school in the correct PE kit. English We will use the story of Red Riding Hood and Last Stop on Market Street by Matt De La Pena to help our narrative writing. In our non-fiction writing we be writing recounts. We will use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces; the joining word 'and'; suffixes –ed, and –ing; the un-prefix, question marks and exclamation marks. Maths We will we learn about place value work within 20 and addition and subtraction within 10. We will also learn about 2D and 3D shapes. Religion We will focus on family, belonging and waiting. Through our learning we will explore the love shown in the family and learn how God loves and cares for everyone. We will explore Baptism as an invitation to belong to God's family and Advent as a time of waiting and preparing to celebrate Jesus' coming at Christmas. We will also learn about Hinduism. Science We will learn about seasonal changes. We will explore the key features of the four seasons; the tilt of the earth; temperature; and what happens to trees and plants during the year. We will observe the weather and make recordings. Geography We will learn about the area in which we live by identifying human and physical geographical features on local maps and by exploring how the land use has changed over time. We will use directional language and fieldwork skills to study the geography of our school grounds. History We will learn about toys and how these have changed within living memory. We will investigate toys today and toys from the past, and we will find out what toys our parents/ grandparents played with. We will use time lines to develop our chronological understanding.
