

# Homework Year 1 Autumn 1

## Core Activities

<p><b>Maths</b> (You must complete this activity).</p>	<p><b>English</b> Writing, Grammar, Punctuation or Spelling. (You must complete this activity).</p>	<p><b>English – Reading</b> (You must complete this activity).</p>
<p>We have learnt to make subtraction number sentences using part whole models.</p>  <p>How many different ways can you take away from 10. Draw the part whole model and write subtraction number sentences. e.g. <math>10 - 6 = 4</math> <math>10 - 4 = 6</math></p>	<p>Can you draw a picture of a bus and write all the things you do and see or hear when on a bus ride. e.g tall grey buildings, people walking, busy street etc Maybe you can use these words to write a sentence. e.g. I can hear the pitter patter of rain drops on the bus window.</p>	<p>The children will bring home reading books which will be changed at least once per week. Please listen to your child read daily and encourage them to sound out the words using the sounds they know. They also need to be listening to themselves as they read to help with understanding. The reading books should be brought to school every day.</p>

<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>In Geography our topic is where we live. Have a look at where you live, can you draw your house or your garden and write the things which you can see. Maybe you can write down how you get from inside your house to your garden. ( E.g. I walk out of the living room into the hallway, into the kitchen and through the door to the garden.)</p>
<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>Our topic in RE is “Advent.” (waiting)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Can you make an advent wreath using recycled materials from around your home.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>In Science we will be learning about seasonal change.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Can you write a list of things you see or do in each season. (e.g Winter – wear warm clothes, Christmas, snow.)</li> <li>You might like to add the months of the year for each season on your list.</li> </ul>
<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>This term we are learning about communities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make a poster showing how you can make your community better (eg: kindness, gentleness, friendship, sharing, listening)</li> </ul>
<p><b>British Values</b></p> <p>This term we are learning about respect.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>We are all different. Draw a picture showing how you respect other people.</li> </ul>
