Class Information

Reading Books – reading books will be changed every 3 or 4 days depending on RWI book colour.
Homework will be given at the beginning of the term, to be handed in at the end of the half-term
P.E. is every Thursday and Friday.

<u>English</u>	Our main phonic scheme is Read Write Inc. Books for the term – Little Red Reading Hood, The Great Fire of London, If I were in charge of the world, The Marvellous Fluffy Squishy Itty Bitty, My Christmas Star and Meerkat Christmas. Writing Opportunities – character description, setting description, letters, diary entry and narrative, information, poetry
<u>Maths</u>	Number – multiplication and division Addition and Subtraction Money Place Value Properties of Shape
<u>Religion</u>	Belonging, Baptism and Advent
<u>Science</u>	In science the children will explore the development of materials over time, including researching some of the key material innovators. They will investigate different materials and consider those which are best to use for certain tasks. The children will also learn about how humans grow from babies to adults and they will get the chance to compare this life cycle with that of other animals, such as frogs and butterflies. By looking at a range of species, children will be able to consider the ways different organisms give birth.
<u>Geography</u>	We will be learning about our local area and where we live. We will explore aerial photographs and maps and identify a range of geographical features. We will explore the school and its school grounds and design our own maps. We will follow a route on a map and use locational language to describe how to get from one place to another.
<u>History</u>	The children will learn about The Great Fire of London. They will learn about why the fire started, how long it burned for and the affects on London.
<u>Art</u>	The children will be learning about the artist Frida Kahlo
<u>Design & Technology</u>	The children will be looking at and making mechanisms.
<u>Computing</u>	Questioning, effective searching and creating pictures.
<u>Music</u>	The children will follow Charanga to complete the themes of 'Hand Feet Heart' and 'Ho Ho Ho'.

<u>P.E.</u>	Balls Skills and Fundamentals
