

Core Activities		
Maths (You must complete this activity).	English Writing, Grammar, Punctuation or Spelling. (You must complete this activity).	English – Reading (You must complete this activity).
Count forwards and backwards to 100 in ones. Count in 2s up to 30 forwards and backwards. Count in 5s up to 100 forwards and backwards. Count in 10s up to 100 forwards and backwards.	The children will be bringing home some reading activities and/or grammar activities every Monday and these need completing and handing in the following Monday.	The children will bring home 2 reading books which will be changed once a week. Your child's changing days are in their reading diary. The children should be reading daily. Encourage your child to sound out the words using the sounds they know. They also need to be listening to themselves as they read to help with understanding. The reading books should be brought to school every day. Your child will also bring home a story to share. This is a book to be read by an adult, to be shared.
